

Child Post-Doctoral Fellowship at the Center for Anxiety, Brooklyn Office

The Center for Anxiety invites applications for two post-doctoral fellowships in Child Clinical Psychology at our Brooklyn location, beginning September of 2017.

The Center for Anxiety is an independent specialty clinic with three offices in the New York area (Manhattan, Brooklyn, Spring Valley) and also in Boston, MA, providing evidence-based treatments to adults, adolescents, and children for an array of emotional disorders. Our Brooklyn office specializes in the provision of behavior therapy for anxiety, obsessive-compulsive spectrum, impulse-control (e.g., trichotillomania, tics) and disruptive behavior disorders in children ages 2-12. Our family-centric approach typically involves family consultations and behavioral parent-training to target family accommodation alongside traditional individual treatment with children. We are also proud to house the only Parent-Child Interaction Therapy (PCIT) facility in Brooklyn.

Clinical outcomes are rigorously evaluated by our fully funded on-site research laboratory through the use of cutting-edge software, to provide real-time feedback to clinicians and patients throughout the treatment process. In addition, we regularly offer educational programs to the community as well as training/supervision programs to local area schools and clinicians, focused on how to implement and evaluate non-pharmacological, behavioral approaches in a variety of settings.
