Qualified candidates will have completed an APA-accredited doctoral program in clinical or school-clinical psychology, as well as a one-year pre-doctoral internship placement in clinical psychology. A strong CBT training background and prior CBT experience with children, adolescents, and young adults are required.

Based on the candidate's interests and experience, the fellow may also have the opportunity to lead/co-lead workshops in the community, conduct neuropsychological assessments, collaborate on research and/or writing projects, take on leadership, supervisory, and program development roles within CFI, and obtain further training and/or experience in specialized cognitive and behavioral therapies for a broad range of youth emotional and behavior disorders.
