

**Postdoctoral Fellowship in Clinical Child Psychology
2017-2018 Academic Year**

The Center for Pediatric Psychiatry at Children's HealthSM Children's Medical Center in Dallas, Texas is accepting additional applications for two positions within its APA-accredited Postdoctoral Fellowship in Clinical Child Psychology beginning August 21, 2017. The new application deadline for these two positions will be midnight CST, January 20th, 2017.

We are currently accepting applications for two positions, each within one area of specialization:

Suicide/depression Concentration (1 position)

- This position offers the opportunity to train with leading experts in suicide and depression of children and adolescents
- The postdoctoral fellowship will focus on evaluation and evidence based treatment of suicidality and depression in adolescents. Experience will span the full spectrum of psychiatric care including inpatient, intensive outpatient, and outpatient levels.
- The postdoctoral fellow will have the opportunity to train in various evidence based interventions, including group therapy, individual/family therapy, and multifamily therapy.

Eating Disorders Concentration (1 position)

- Evaluation and treatment of children and adolescents with anorexia nervosa, bulimia nervosa, atypical anorexia, and avoidant/restrictive food intake disorder.
- Individual, family, and group therapy; psychological assessment; behavioral programs & parent education within a multidisciplinary treatment approach.
- Experiences span the full continuum of care (Inpatient, Partial Hospitalization, Intensive Outpatient, Outpatient).
- The postdoc in this position will work primarily at the campus in Plano, TX.

Requirements:

Applicants must have a Ph.D. or Psy.D. from an APA-accredited doctoral program and must have completed an internship from an APA-accredited program, with degree requirements met **AND degree conferred** by the first day of fellowship.

Materials required will include:

1. Cover letter, describing the following:

- Concentration area and position of interest (each applicant may apply for only one concentration or position)
 - Statement of interest and fit with the position
 - Accreditation status of graduate and internship programs
 - Anticipated date of degree conferral
 - Names of recommenders who will be sending letters
2. Curriculum vitae (CV)
 3. Three letters of recommendation
 4. Degree conferral attestation form, signed by applicant and advisor (available on program website)

Requirements:

Applicants must have a Ph.D. or Psy.D. from an APA-accredited doctoral program and must have completed an internship from an APA-accredited program, with degree requirements met **AND degree conferred** by the first day of fellowship.
