

Fordham University, Department of Psychology: One Assistant or Associate Professor tenure-track position in Clinical Psychology to begin August 2017.

The Department is located on both campuses of Fordham University (Rose Hill and Lincoln Center), but this position will be primarily at the Rose Hill campus. The Department of Psychology offers doctoral degrees in Applied Developmental Psychology, Clinical Psychology, and Psychometrics/Quantitative Psychology. Responsibilities include teaching undergraduate and graduate courses, establishing and maintaining a productive independent program of research, mentoring undergraduate research and graduate students' theses and dissertations, and supervising clinical work of graduate students.

Candidates must have earned a Ph.D. in clinical psychology and completed an APA- or CPA-approved internship prior to their appointment, and be license eligible in the state of New York. Candidate with expertise in health psychology, or those whose research emphasizes issues of diversity and/or health disparities are strongly encouraged, although applicants with any clinical psychology focus will be considered. The ideal candidate will have an established record of external funding or clear potential to obtain external funding, publications, and teaching experience. Fordham is an independent, Catholic University in the Jesuit tradition that welcomes applications from all backgrounds. The University and Department have a strong commitment to achieving diversity among faculty and staff. We are particularly interested in receiving applications from members of underrepresented groups and strongly encourage persons of color and persons with disabilities to apply.
