

Please distribute our announcement for one opening for our post-doctoral training program in research at the University of Minnesota's Minnesota Center for Chemical and Mental Health:

Minnesota Center for Chemical and Mental Health (MNCAMH) at the University of Minnesota, College of Education and Human Development, in the School of Social Work has an opening for a post-doctoral fellow. This Postdoc will participate in research and clinical training on grant-funded projects under the direction of the principal investigator (PI)/MNCAMH Executive Director. The position will have opportunities to conduct research, training and consultation with clinicians in evidence based models for treating persons with First Episode Psychosis and Mental Health, Substance Use Disorders, Co-occurring Disorders and other integrated health improvement initiatives. Research responsibilities generally involve participation in the design, implementation, and evaluation of research projects. He/She may participate in preparation and presentation of data to study investigators and stakeholders. The position will have opportunities to develop areas of specialty clinical practice, research design and implementation, publication of research reports, and grant writing. There will also be opportunities to provide treatment in clinical settings focused on treatment for early psychosis and co-occurring mental health and substance use disorders.

This position is grant funded for one year with the potential for additional 12-month renewal. Renewals are dependent on need, research funding, and performance of individual in position.
