Post-Doctoral Fellow Job Posting

The Department of Psychology at Drexel University in Philadelphia, PA is seeking a post-doctoral fellow to begin in Summer or Fall of 2017. The fellowship will primarily entail working with Meghan Butryn, Ph.D., on NIH-funded clinical trials examining innovations in behavioral therapy for obesity. This position will have both clinical and research components, with approximately 25%/75% allocation of time for clinical and research tasks, respectively. The fellow will conduct data analyses, prepare poster and paper submissions for conferences, write manuscripts, and receive mentorship in grant writing. He or she will lead treatment groups and conduct assessments of potential participants, supervise research staff, provide training to graduate students, and have some data management responsibility. There will be opportunities for involvement in other research projects, including pilot studies of his or her own initiation. The training experience is designed to build expertise in clinical research in the areas of obesity treatment and physical activity promotion.
