

Postdoctoral Position in EBT Dissemination at the University of Delaware

We are recruiting for a new postdoctoral position in the Infant Caregiver Project at the University of Delaware. Dr. Mary Dozier and her students and staff at the Infant Caregiver Project study an intervention for high-risk children, the Attachment and Biobehavioral Catch-up (ABC), assess the effectiveness of the intervention, and disseminate the intervention to national and international sites.

We would like to interview individuals interested in joining our team's dissemination efforts.
