Under the supervision and mentorship of the Center Director ([Madhukar H. Trivedi, MD](#)) and the head of the Risk and Resilience Network ([Jennifer L. Hughes, Ph.D.](#)), the postdoctoral researcher will advance her or his training in research focusing on the evaluation of mental health promotion programs and treatments and services for youth depression and suicide prevention, as well as strategies for effective dissemination of evidence-based treatments and services. Our programs are offered through a variety of partnerships with the community and school systems, as well as through various service settings including mental health, primary care, and family medicine services.

The postdoctoral researcher may:

- a. participate in the development and delivery of school-based mental health promotion programs and interventions addressing youth depression;
- b. develop, design and conduct research efforts in line with this research plan;
- c. formulate research methods and suggest improvements for quality and serve as part of a team;
- d. coordinate database management, conduct data analysis, and interpret results;
- e. perform research related activities in a laboratory setting;
- f. co-author or author publications.

This position is a full-time, one-year funded position, with the option for a second year. Salary and benefits commensurate with NIH rates based on experience and qualifications.

Required Qualifications:

1. A Ph.D. in clinical psychology, or related field
2. At least one year of experience with project-related research methodology
3. Excellent writing and analytic skills as evidenced by application materials, peer-reviewed publications, dissertation, or writing sample
4. Strong verbal communication skills as evidenced by work and/or education experience and interview process
