

## Research Associate in Fort Carson, CO

The National Center for Veterans Studies (NCVS) is seeking a full-time, benefited Research Associate based out of Fort Carson, Colorado.

The research associate is responsible for recruiting and enrolling participants, completing informed consent, supervising administration of self report measures, entering data into the study database, and assisting with on-site coordination of study activities. The study (Primary Care Screening Methods (PRISM) Study: Improving Universal Suicide Prevention Screening in Primary Care by Reducing False Negatives) is overseen and operated through the University of Utah. The study will be conducted within primary care clinics located at multiple Department of Defense installations. Secondary opportunities include working on data analysis, manuscript preparation, and presenting research at national conferences. The research associate will be trained and supervised by postdoctoral staff and graduate students under the guidance of Dr. Craig Bryan, a military suicide researcher and licensed clinical psychologist. A bachelors degree in a medical or health care services field (e.g., psychology, social work, public health, medicine) is preferred.
