

The Department of Psychology at Southeastern Louisiana University invites applicants for an Assistant or Associate Professor tenure-track position beginning in the Fall of 2017. The successful candidate must have Ph.D. or Ed.D. in Psychology, Applied Behavior Analysis, or a closely related discipline from an accredited university by the hire date and be eligible for board certification in applied behavior analysis (BCBA); certification must be obtained prior to August 2018. Candidates must show a strong commitment to excellence in teaching and scholarship. The successful candidate will be expected to teach both undergraduate and graduate courses in psychology, maintain an active scholarly program, supervise student research, and perform departmental and university service. The candidate will also coordinate an Applied Behavior Analysis concentration at the undergraduate level. Applicants must be committed to working with diversity.
