

## **Post-Doctoral Position in Anxiety Disorders Research at the Center for Understanding and treating Anxiety (SDSU/UCSD)**

The Center for Understanding and Treating Anxiety at San Diego State University invites applications for a Post-Doctoral fellow or research scientist. The Center specializes in translational research as well as Cognitive-Behavioral therapy (CBT) for Anxiety Disorders in adults and children. The primary responsibility of the fellow will be to help conduct clinical research projects including NIMH-funded investigations prevention and treatment of anxiety disorders. The responsibilities will also include working with adults and children with Obsessive-Compulsive Disorder, Social Phobia, and Posttraumatic Stress Disorders with an emphasis on combining CBT and Cognitive Bias Modification (CBM) and EEG. Research interests in information processing bias and link to biological markers (EEG, fMRI) a plus.

The fellow will gain experience in grant writing and will have opportunities to develop an individual program of research, as well as collaborate with federally funded, multi-disciplinary team of researchers in San Diego. In addition, the fellows will provide CBT for adults, adolescents, and children with primary anxiety disorders. Qualifications include a doctoral degree in clinical psychology, solid research training including evidence of scholarly productivity, as well as experience with EEG. Review of applications will begin immediately and will continue until the position is filled. However, applications will be accepted until positions are filled. More in-depth research interests in information processing bias and link to biological markers (EEG, fMRI) a plus. Start date for the position is June September, 2017.
