

Clinical Psychology Postdoctoral Fellowship Position Announcement

LivingRite, The Center for Behavioral Health (private practice) - Sycamore, IL, USA - 1 post-doctoral fellowship in clinical psychology

Position Description: We are pleased to accept applications for a one-year Postdoctoral Fellowship in our large group private practice. This one-year Postdoctoral Fellowship offers opportunities to see clients in individual, group, or family therapy modalities; weekly professional supervision (1-2 hours); and professional development activities. The postdoctoral fellow can see a wide variety of presenting problems as supervision allows. Opportunities to train on our specialty teams are seen as a strength of our program. Specialty Teams include the OCD and Anxiety Disorders Team, PTSD and Trauma Recovery Team, Eating Disorders Team, and Women's Health Team. There are also opportunities for the fellow to participate in a weekly consultation group (general) and a weekly DBT consultation group. Finally, fellows are encouraged to partake in our quarterly didactic series.

Practice Description: LivingRite, The Center for Behavioral Health is a large group practice with three locations currently serving the far west suburbs of Chicago, IL. Our current locations are in Sycamore IL and Pingree Grove IL. We also have plans to expand to the Tricities area by fall 2017. Therapists and Psychologists on staff have a diverse set of specialties, therapeutic orientations, and degrees.

Start Date and Compensation: The position would start ideally August 2017 with some flexibility. The accepted applicant for this full-time position will become an employee of LivingRite, The Center for Behavioral Health, with competitive compensation of \$45,000+ for full time status (final compensation is based on caseload).
