

## Post-Doctoral Fellowship Opening

Researchers in the Department of Medical and Clinical Psychology at the Uniformed Services University (USU) in Bethesda, MD, are looking for a post-doctoral fellow for a therapy trial aimed at preventing eating disorders and reducing excess weight gain in adolescent military dependents. The position will involve conducting group interpersonal psychotherapy and psychiatric assessments for boys and girls at high-risk for eating disorders and obesity. Responsibilities also include overseeing research coordinators in the recruitment of study participants and data collection. The ideal candidate will have a doctorate in clinical psychology or a related field. Some prior experience working with adolescents and/or individuals with eating and weight problems is preferred, but not required. A two year commitment is requested.

Opportunities for this position include:

- training and supervision in short-term psychotherapy
- mentorship from expert collaborators in the fields of endocrinology and psychiatry at the NIH Clinical Center
- encouragement and mentorship in development of an independent research program

Positions will begin summer of 2017. Applications will be reviewed as they are received. Competitive full-time salary plus benefits.
