Psychology/Psy.D. – to teach in both the APA-accredited Psy.D. program in combined school and clinical psychology and the NASP-accredited Master's/professional diploma program in school psychology (<http://grad.kean.edu/doctoral-programs/combined-school-and-clinical-psychology>). Other duties include, but are not limited to: mentoring graduate students in school and clinical psychology; overseeing dissertations; and supervising clinical practica in the department's training clinic.

Preference will be given to a candidate who possesses a strong practitioner-scholar or scientist-practitioner philosophy, an ongoing program of research as demonstrated by peer reviewed publications and national conference presentations, and potential for extramural funding.

Qualifications: Doctoral degree in clinical, school or combined school and clinical psychology is required. Clinical and/or research interests in the areas of adult assessment and intervention is preferred. Interest in teaching courses in statistics and research methodology is also desirable.
